<u>Keeler UK</u> – Medical equipment manufacturing – Ophthalmology sector – have very kindly agreed to fund and set up a **school library system** for Hilltop. Currently looking at options for this and working with a Hilltop parent who is employed at Keeler. Possibility of Keeler designing a system themselves for us to use, with excel. Ongoing discussions between Keeler, Melissa and Ms Bima.

<u>Keeler UK</u> – have also kindly agreed to create and fund a **vegetable patch** out on the playing field at the back of Hilltop. Children can learn all about how to grow your own and take part in the process. Ms Bima has suggested that we ask Keeler if they would mind us using that money instead to purchase children's gardening tools instead ie. Gloves, spades, watering cans and a large container to keep them in, in one the outdoor sheds.

• Possible items to contribute towards / fundraise for this year, as discussed with Ms Bima:-

Large outdoor games for KS1 & KS2 – giant jenga, snakes and ladders..etc (make use of prime day? Tue and Wed next week and also Black Friday in November) (£40-75 each). IKEA dolls house and wooden dolls for the house which can be bought off Amazon.

'Cosy Play' - wooden blocks in the main playground

Climbing wall (6m approx £2,500) – no official quote made but could get the School Fun Run (due April 2024) to finance it.

Non-fiction books. Current ones in library very old and need replacing. Could set up an Amazon 'wish list'.
