What is a Home School Agreement?

A Home School Agreement is a statement explaining the school's aims and values, the school's responsibility to the children, the responsibility of the parents and carers and what the school expects of the children.

For the children at our school to achieve their full potential they need:

- ★ To feel valued, safe and included within the school community.
- * To be motivated through interesting teaching and a stimulating environment
- * Opportunities to have a go, explore and be curious
- * Praise and encouragement from all adults involved in their education in school and at home.
- * To take responsibility for their own learning behaviour

This can be most effectively achieved when all staff, parents and children understand their responsibilities and work together towards the same goals, as detailed in this Home School agreement.

The Home

We ask parents/carers to agree to:

- Model the importance of good attendance and punctuality; avoid taking holidays in term time
- Ensure their child wears the correct full school uniform
- Support their child's learning at home and at school
- Promote Hilltop Values and British Values across the whole school community
- Support the school's policies and Golden Rules
- Keep an open dialogue with school staff about their child
- Attend parent/carer consultations, curriculum evenings and discussions about their child's progress
- Ensure that their child has adequate rest and is prepared for the busy day
- Inform the school on the first day about any absence
- Notify the school if their child is going to be collected by another person
- Support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community

- Not share photos taken at school events on social media sites if they include other children
- Park safely and considerately ensuring the safety of all children and demonstrating respect for the local residents
