



Spring 2020 2nd Half Term – Reception

Half way through the year already! It has been lovely to see the children blossoming in confidence and self-esteem throughout the year and the progress they have made in learning new letter sounds.

Last term, the children loved learning about Space and got fully engrossed in a range of activities throughout the topic. They learnt the names of the planets and enjoyed singing songs about aliens, rockets and planets. We turned our role play area in to a spaceship where the children had access to technology to act out being astronauts flying to Space. We read a range of stories to reflect this learning and enjoyed hearing non-fiction books about Space as well. We have been so impressed with how much information the children are able to retain!

This term, Team Woodland will be learning about Superheroes. This is an enjoyable topic for the children with so many opportunities to widen their imagination. We will be reading stories including: 'Eliot Midnight Superhero' by Anne Cottringer, 'Superworm' by Julia Donaldson and many other stories based around this theme. Personal, Social & Emotional Development

'Superheroes' will be an opportunity to explore being helpful, caring and responsible. The children will develop their understanding of right and wrong and how they can resolve problems. We will look at developing a "Growth Mindset" which encourages reframing of negative thoughts (I can't do this, it's too hard) positively (this is going to take some time and effort), focusing on a different "super" attribute.

Communication & Language

As the children become 'Superheroes', they will be faced with lots of 'challenges.' This will involve them in being able to take into account listener's needs and how to help them. We will focus on the children communicating effectively when talking about the past, present and future.

Physical Development

As 'Superheroes' the children will learn explore in many different ways to 'save the world!' We will encourage them to take risks and safely negotiate space. We will provide physical opportunities for the children to explore.

Literacy

This term, we will be encouraging the children to write simple sentences using their knowledge of sounds which will enable them to read their own sentences.

Maths

The children will continue to look at addition and subtraction. This term, they will be adding and subtracting two one-digit numbers and use the language of 'adding,' and 'taking away'.'

Understanding the World

The children will be exploring how to 'rescue victims' from earth and water. This will include looking at the different states of water e.g. ice to water and water to ice.

Expressive Arts

This is a fabulous opportunity for the children to use their imagination as they begin to act out being a real superhero. They will construct tall buildings, bridges and other scenarios.
