



Autumn 2022 2nd Half Term – Reception

Welcome back! We hope you had a restful half term and ready for the new term. Before the holidays, the children wowed us with their learning as we looked at different types of houses and bridges across the world based upon on Traditional Tales. The children were able to explain why some houses are built on warmer countries and why others are built in colder climates.

This term, we are looking at seasonal changes with a focus on autumn and winter. We will learn about what happens to the weather, changes to the trees in the autumn, what happens to some animals and how the weather changes as we approach winter. We will also begin to practice our Christmas play as there are many songs to learn! We are looking forward to celebrating Christmas in school again and we have many exciting events happening as we approach the end of term.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Last term, the children focused on getting to know one another and developing friendships. Whilst we continue to work on this, we will also encourage the children to resolve conflicts between one another by explaining their wants and needs.

Communication & Language

We will be exploring new vocabulary as we learn about our topic. The children will learn about hibernation and explain this in their own way, describe the leaves and trees and use instrumental music and images to explain a story.

Physical Development

This term, we will use the outdoor area to continue to develop our gross motor skills. We will be learning to pedal using the tricycles, using parts of the climbing frame with a focus and learning how to throw and catch balls of different sizes.

Literacy

As we have learnt the single sounds using Letterland, we will begin to learn how to blend sounds and learning about 'Tricky' words. We will also start thinking about recognising initial sounds to words.

Maths

This term, the children will be exploring the number 6 in a variety of ways. They will learn to make 6, different ways it is represented and look at numbers on a number line. We will also be learning about 2D shapes and their properties.

Understanding the World

This topic lends itself so well to understanding of the world as we investigate seasonal changes. The children will look at what happens to plants and trees, why animals hibernate and why the weather changes.

Expressive Arts

We will continue to work on using tools to develop our fine motor skills including using split pins, cellotape and masking tape to attach materials together. We will also be singing lots of Christmas songs in preparation for our play!
