This term, Team Woodland will be learning about Aliens and Space. This is an enjoyable topic for the children with so many opportunities to widen their imagination. Personal, Social & Emotional Development

The children this term will continue to build on their confidence and self-awareness. The children are starting to become more confident in sharing ideas with their peers during class discussions.

Communication & Language

The children will continue to build and develop their vocabulary and extend their use of language, looking at how and why questions in response to stories and events about space. The children will continue to develop their own narrative and explanation by linking ideas together.

Physical Development

The children will continue to expand their physical development through looking at different movements, as they explore walking and moving in space. They will build on their fine and gross motor skills and explore throwing and catching.

Literacy

We will build on the children's reading and writing skills continuing to use Letterland. We will look at new sounds and build words using sounds we already know. Please read with vour child at least four times a week.

Maths

This term in maths we will be focusing more on shape, measure and space. The learning will include understanding 2D and 3D shapes using the terms flat and solid, introducing the children to the names of shapes and creating objects using shapes.

Understanding the World

As the children will be learning about space, they will learn what is above in space, what planet Earth looks like and how we would travel to the moon.

Expressive Arts

The children will exploring how to use materials to construct a sculpture. We will also be using Paper Mache and experiment with colour. We love to use messy play to extend their creativity.
