

Spring 2023 2nd Spring Term – Reception

We hope you had a wonderful half term. It is lovely to see the sun shining a bit longer and the warmer months approaching.

The children enjoyed learning about 'Transport' as we discovered forms of transport which are cleaner for the air and those that cause more pollution. We spoke about which vehicles are better as they provide more seats for passengers, but we discovered that cycling, walking or going on our scooters was not only good exercise, but cleaner for the air.

This term, we will be learning about 'Space.' We will begin looking at our world and planet Earth talking about the 'green' and 'blue' parts. We will explore ways in which we can look after our planet by recycling, saving water and looking after ourselves and the animals. As part of the Space topic, we will also be learning about the sun and how this allows us to have day, exploring stars and the moon at night and thinking about gravity in Space and what this means. To end the topic, we will be reading, 'Aliens love Underpants,'

Personal, Social & Emotional Development As we will be reading the story, 'Aliens Love Underpants,' this story will highlight the importance body parts and keeping certain parts private as they are personal to us.

Communication & Language We will continue to think about and use words to describe and explain what happens in Space. For example, the children will be exploring how shadows are formed, the sun setting and rising, gravity and looking after our world.

Physical Development
This term, the children will
be developing their ball skills
by throwing, kicking and
dropping a ball to investigate
'gravity.' We will also be
jumping on two feet and
swinging on a rope.

Literacy The children are working so well on blending sounds read words sounding out words to write them. We will continue to work on this and encourage the children to read and write. The sounds we will be focusing on are: ff, ss, s, -es, j, v, w, x, y, z, qu, ng, ing

Maths This term, we will continue to look at number focusing particularly on numbers 7-9. The children will learn to recognise, count and find number bonds to We will also continue to write numbers 0-9.

Understanding the World

As we are learning about Space, we will be looking at our planet and how we can look after it. The children will learn about recycling materials, looking after the animals and saving water.

Expressive Arts
The children will be creating models of Earth and the other planets using various materials and tools. We will also be working on our fine motor by continuing to use the tripod grip, cutting more accurately and using a hole puncher.
