



Autumn 2019 1st Half Term- Year 1

Hello and welcome from the new Team Enchantment. We hope you all had a great Summer Holiday and are looking forward to the year ahead. We would like to welcome Mr Hickling, Miss Reith, Mrs Daly, and Miss Instone to the team. They have already settled in brilliantly.

We have a busy year ahead and the aim of these updates is to keep you informed of team specific information and dates that will be useful to you. These will include things like dates for trips, workshops and important events. We will ensure that throughout the year we provide lots of opportunities to talk about how you can support your children at home with different activities for their learning.

The classes in Team Enchantment are as follows:

Castle (Year 2) – Miss Wright, Miss Reith and Mrs Daly

Meadow (Year 1) – Miss Hughes and Mrs Dyson

Treetops (Year 1&2) – Mr Hickling and Miss Instone

English

- ★ **Traditional Tales and stories with alternative endings:** We will be teaching English through a skills based approach, ensuring that the children have a good grasp of the basic fundamental skills including: full stops, capital letters, finger spacing and spelling phonetically.
- ★ **Reading:** The children will enjoy listening to a range of traditional tales and stories with alternative endings. The children will also have daily reading sessions and will be given both a Ruth Miskin book and a banded coloured *free choice* book to practice at home.
- ★ **Phonics:** The children will have daily phonics sessions to build on their knowledge. Please ensure you check the home school book for sounds your child is focusing on. Practice that is little and often is the key to success!

Maths

★ Number and Place Value:

The children will be focusing on recognising, ordering, reading and writing numbers up to 20. They will work out numbers that are one more or one less than a given number. They will also be comparing numbers using **greater than (>)** and **less than (<)** symbols.

$$20 < 24$$

20 is less than 24

$$15 > 12$$

15 is greater than 12

★ Counting:

The children will be learning to count forwards and backwards in different increments (1s and 10s) they will use their early number skills to spot patterns in different counting sequences. They will be learning songs to help them remember key facts about the different numbers they consider.

Experienceology

Celebrate and Remember

The children will be exploring the theme of 'Celebrate and Remember' through the different subjects in a creative and hands-on way.

- ★ **History:** The children will be going back in time to learn about The Gunpowder Plot. They will have a chance to enquire, ask questions and discover some of the key events during this time.
- ★ **Science:** The children will be looking at different materials and exploring their properties. They will link this area of learning with their art and DT to think about appropriate materials for making their own cart.
- ★ **Art/DT:** The children will be creating their own Rangoli patterns using different medians. They will be using what they've learnt in science to build a cart, similar to one that Guy Fawkes may have used.

Team Enchantment reminders for this half term

- ★ Please ensure your child has their **full, labelled** PE kit for the term and that it stays in school. Children must have black trainers for PE and NOT plimsolls.

- ★ As a way of supporting the children in Key Stage One with their Phonics (the learning of sounds), Reading and SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar), you are invited to a shared Phonics and SPaG based session every Friday morning 8.50-9.05. The children will be able to apply their English knowledge in fun and vibrant ways and it will provide an opportunity for parents to pick up tips on how best to support their children's reading and writing at home. The first session will begin on Friday 27th September.
