As we begin our final term of this academic year we are really thinking about celebrating our successes and achievements during this school year. We have enjoyed watching Treetops share all they have been learning and look forward to Castle and Meadows sharing assemblies. It has been a very busy year and the children have worked very hard.....

English

★ Instruction Writing

We will be linking our learning with our Experienceology topic and looking at writing instructions for making a healthy sandwich. We will start off by identifying the features of instructions such as, the title, the ingredients/ equipment list and the method.

★ **Reading:** The children will be sharing and finding features of instructions for different things. They will also have daily reading sessions. Please continue to read frequently at home!

★ **Phonics:** The children will continue to have daily phonics sessions to build on their knowledge.

★ **Spellings:** Weekly spelling lists will continue to come home every **Thursday**. Please check their Home School Book for any updates.

Maths

★ Data handling

We will also be looking at interpreting and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables as a form of collecting data. The children will be learning to ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting the categories by quantity. They will then be looking at asking and answering questions about totalling and comparing categorical data.

★ Sequencing events and repeating patterns

The children will be learning to describe position, through recognising and creating simple repeating patterns with objects and shapes. They will also look at describing movement in straight lines using everyday language and describe turns, including half, quarter and three-quarter turns in both directions and connect turning clockwise with movement on a clock face.

Experienceology Our Wonderful Selves

★ Computing and E-Safety:

We will be learning about self-image and identity, privacy and security, online relationships and online bullying, health, wellbeing and lifestyle. The children will learn how to keep themselves safe online.

★ Geography: Maps

The children will be planning and undertaking a route to a local park in the Windsor area using their knowledge of maps and local landmarks.



★ Science/Art and D+T: Healthy Eating

In class the children will be researching, planning, preparing and evaluating a healthy sandwich.
