



Summer 2024 1st Half Term - Year 1

We cannot believe that we are into the last term already, this year has flown by! The children are in lovely routines now and it is so lovely to see them coming into classrooms with big smiles on their faces every day. We have a busy term ahead of us with lots to fit in before the summer holidays. The children have been introduced to our 'Rainforests' topic this week and we are sure that they are going to enjoy the learning we have planned.

English

★ **Fiction writing:** This term the children will be learning how to write creatively. We will be using a number of stories to share high quality creative texts and the children will base their writing on these books. We will begin to look at descriptive language to write character and setting descriptions and how to use more interesting vocabulary. The children will also be writing stories of their own.

★ **Phonics** The children have a few more new sounds to learn and then we will spend some time recapping sounds that they have already learnt. It is important that the children can recognise sounds on their own but also in words so that they can read and write using their phonic knowledge. Please continue to practise reading Letterland readers at home to support continued progress.

★ **Spelling:** Please continue to practise spellings with your children at home. They need to be becoming more and more confident with spelling high frequency words correctly.

★ Multiplication and Division

The children have come back in after the Easter break raring to go and have been able to jump back in to our Multiplication and Division topic. The children are becoming confident at making equal groups to multiply and divide. They are beginning to use arrays and are getting their heads around recognising the rows and columns. There is an example of an array below.



★ Fractions

Before half term the children will begin to learn about fractions. This follows on nicely from division as they are still learning to share equally. In Year 1 children are expected to know halves and quarters of shapes, sets of objects and numbers.
