Welcome back after what was hopefully an enjoyable and restful half term break. The first half term went by in the blink of an eye and we are sure that this half term will be no different! English

★ Word and sentence building:

The children have made a good start last term at writing words correctly and making phonically plausible attempts at words they can't spell yet.

We have been learning how to write grammatically correct sentences which we describe as 'good sentences'. Good sentences contain a noun and a verb. We are practising using capital letter, finger spaces and full stops.

★ **Reading:** The children have greatly enjoyed listening to chapter books during class reading assemblies. They have also been working hard on their individual reading and are beginning to develop fluency when reading aloud.

★ **Phonics:** The children will continue to have daily phonics sessions to build on their knowledge. They are beginning to write and read more during these lessons and will be incorporating the sounds they have previously learnt.

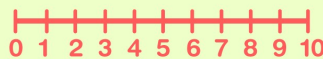
Maths

★ Addition and Subtraction:

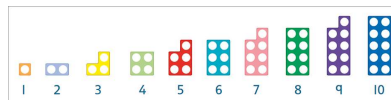
The children will be learning how to read, write and interpret the +, - and = signs.

We will be using number bond knowledge to work on addition and subtraction.

The children will be using number lines and concrete manipulatives to support them with adding and subtracting. The children will be encouraged to count on using number lines like the one below.



We will begin to work on solving simple word problems using manipulatives such as bead strings, Numicon and counting resources.
