English

★ **Sentence building:** We will begin by looking at our phonics sounds to write short sentences. The children will explore different words with the phonics focus and then think about how a sentence has a noun in it and begin writing a short sentence.

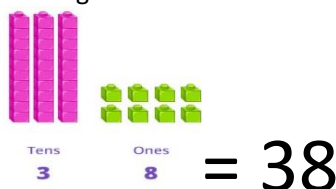
★ **Reading:** The children will enjoy listening to a range of stories and will begin listening to a class chapter book. The children will continue with guided reading sessions and will begin written comprehension lessons weekly in order to improve their skills in this area.

★ **Phonics:** The children will have daily phonics sessions to build on their knowledge. We will continue to learn through the Letterland scheme that has proven very popular with the children in previous years.

Maths

★ Number and Place Value:

The children will be focusing on recognising, ordering, reading and writing numbers up to 100. They will think about the value of the number and what it is made up of using the vocabulary tens and ones. They will work out numbers that are one more or ten more than a given number.



★ Addition and Subtraction:

The children will be learning how to add and subtract with numbers up to 100. They will begin by adding/subtracting tens and then move on to adding/subtracting numbers using the column method.
