We hope you all had a restful half term break. We are excited to continue our learning and have got lots of stimulating things planned for the children. Team Enchantment will continue to focus on our topic 'Explore and Discover'. The children are already looking forward to learning about rainforests.


This term we are welcoming Miss Hanid to Castle class. She will be working with Miss Wright until just before Easter.

#### **English**

- \*Non-fiction and poetry: This half term we are going to be focusing on writing poetry about the rainforest and rainforest animals. Towards the end of the term we are going to be writing some non-fiction texts about rainforests.
- ★ Reading: The children are enjoying listening to each other read during guided reading sessions. We will continue to focus on the specific skills needed to deepen their comprehension understanding.
- ★ SPaG: In their SPaG lessons we will continue to use Letterland to revise spelling rules. This term some of the rules we will be learning are silent sounds, different 'o' sounds and 'k' spelling rules.
- ★ Spellings: Please use the personal spelling wall in your child's bag to see their focus spellings for that week they will be circled. Any spellings they have correctly spelt in a previous spelling check will be coloured in. Please do not colour in this spelling wall at home.

#### Maths

★ Properties of 2d and 3d shapes: The children will be learning to recognise and describe shapes according to their propertioes. We will be learning about lines of symmetry and patterns during this unit.



\* Fractions: This term the children will be learning about fractions of shapes and amounts. They will be learning about halves, quarters and thirds. Towards the end of term the children will be comparing fractions and recognising equivalent fractions - '2 quarters is equal to one half.'

#### **Topic Focus**

# Explore and Discover - Rainforests

- ★ Geography: e will be learning about where rainforests are in the world, what continents they are on and what the climate is like in rainforest regions.
- ★ Science: In science we will be learning about animals that are found in rainforests. The children will be learning about how animals have adapted to suit their environment, learning about habitats and in the end about the life cycles of some animals.
- ★ RE: The children will be learning about the religion of Christianity. We will be learning about things that are important to Christians, what they believe about the world and as we get closer to Easter, focusing on the Easter story and the celebrations of Easter.
