Summer 2021 1st Half Term - Year 2

We have hit the ground running and are already beginning to enjoy our new topic of 'We live in Royal Windsor.'
We hope that you all enjoyed your Easter holidays and the beginnings of lockdown easing.
The children have been happy to be back in school and have loved spending time playing on the field during play and lunchtimes. We cannot believe that the summer term has arrived already! We welcome Miss Tuner into Castle class for 4 weeks while Miss Wells is training at another school.

English

- * Non-fiction: The children will spend this half term writing a range of non-fiction pieces based on Windsor. We will look at writing to engage the reader, using a range of sentence types and using sub-headings to organise writing. Throughout this half term the children will learn a lot of content about Windsor and will also have the chance to learn about and compare with a town from Japan.
- ★ Spellings: Please continue to use the 'home' spelling wall in your child's bag to see their focus spellings for that week they will be circled/ticked. Any spellings they have correctly spelt in a previous spelling check will be coloured in. Please do not colour in this spelling wall at home. It is important that this remains in book bags at all times to ensure that the children can update them when they spell words correctly in school.
- ★ Phonics: We will continue to teach the children new sounds each week. Prepare and Share sheets will now look a little different and will focus on reading comprehension.

Maths

- ★ Measurement Length and Height: The children will be learning about measurement at the start of this half term. They will be learning how to use a ruler and a meter stick accurately. We will discuss the sensible unit of measurement for different objects based on their length or height.
- ★ 2d and 3d shapes: We will be looking naming at recognising a range of 2d and 3d shapes recapping and building on the learning from last year. The children will look at naming properties of the shapes such as sides, vertices, faces etc. We will be learning about lines of symmetry in 2d shapes and comparing similarities and differences between 3d shapes.



Topic

We Live in Royal Windsor

- ★ History: We will be focusing on the Royal Family and which Royals have lived in Windsor Castle throughout the years. The children will also be learning about the history of the changing of the guard.
- ★ Science: This half term the children will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will look at vegetable patches and the environment that plants need to grow as well as what animals need to be kept away from the vegetables.
- ★ Geography: We will be looking at a range of maps and finding Windsor on them. The children will also use maps of their local area to find local landmarks and use directional language to discuss what they can see on the maps.
- ★ RSHE: We are learning all about our amazing bodies this term. The children will learn names of body parts and what our bodies do.
