### **English**


- ★ Writing The children will be looking at a variety of genres whereby they will be encouraged to include the new grammatical techniques and punctuation skills they have been learning. We will be using the text Egyptian Cinderella to help us explore setting and descriptive language.
- ★ In SPaG, we will begin the year by recapping the skills that they learnt in year 2 to ensure that their knowledge is secure. We will then begin to learn about adverbial phrases, prepositions and time conjunctions.
- ★ Reading We will spend some time assessing where the children are at with their reading. It will be important to assess exactly where they are in terms of both their book bands and their comprehension skills.

Reading at home for a minimum 4 days a week is expected.

★ Spellings — Your child will again be given a 'Spelling Wall'. This was started last year and we are continuing with this again. Please encourage your child to practise their new words each week.

### **Maths**

- ★ We will begin the year by looking at two units that were not covered in the previous academic year Time and Position and Movement. We feel it is important to plug any gaps in the children's learning that may have developed due to the school closure.
- ★ Place Value- We will re-cap our knowledge of place value, extending children's knowledge of bigger and more complex numbers. This will also develop their ability to round numbers up and down.



★ Number- We will be using our place value knowledge to secure our understanding of how to apply addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to problem solving. The children will then progress to developing their formal written methods, for example, partitioning and column addition.

## **Foundation Subjects**

The children are excited to be learning about the Ancient Egyptians this term. We have begun by learning a little about who the Ancient Egyptians were, and when and how they lived.

- ★ In **Art** this term the children will begin to develop their own drawing and sketching skills through building a deeper understanding of line, tone and texture. Children will use a range of media such as pencils and charcoal.
- ★ In History and Geography, children will research both historical and geographical features of the Ancient Egyptian civilisation. Including timelines of the major events, Pharaohs, Gods and Goddesses, the importance of the River Nile and the mummification process.
- ★ In Science, we are going to look at Forces and Magnets. In particular we will be experimenting how different surfaces can alter the amount of resistance in the form of friction that is generated. We already have some interesting investigations lined up for this topic.
