The classes in Team Adventure are as follows:



English

- ★ Writing the children will be learning how to construct a first person recount using key features such as: First person pronouns, past tense verbs and emotive language. We will also spend time looking at Fables and Stories with a moral.
- ★ The SPaG skills they will be looking at will include: adverbial phrases, prepositions and time conjunctions.
- ★ Reading- the children will be focusing on comprehension skills and deepening their understanding of a text by bringing their own views and opinions. They will also understand the structure and features of new text types and compare them to texts that they are already familiar with.
- ★ Spellings Your child will soon bring home their new 'Spelling Wall'. We hope that you will enjoy this new format.

Maths

★ Place Value- we will re-cap our knowledge of place value, extending children's knowledge of bigger, and more complex numbers. This will also develop their skills to round numbers up and down.



★ Four Operations- we will be using our place value knowledge to secure our understanding of how to apply addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to problem solving. The children will then progress on to developing their formal written methods, for example, partitioning and column addition.

Topic Learning

The children are excited to be learning about the Ancient Romans this term. We have begun our by learning about what the Romans legacy is in Britain

- ★ In Art this term the children will learn about and create their own mosaic patterns.
- ★ During DT we will be asking the children to design and make their own Roman Shield.
- ★ In **History** and **Geography** children will continue to research both historical and geographical features of the Roman Empire and daily life in Ancient Rome.
- ★ In **Science** we are going to look at Animals, Including Humans, specifically looking at what a healthy and balanced diet looks like, nutrition as well as the skeletal and muscles systems.
