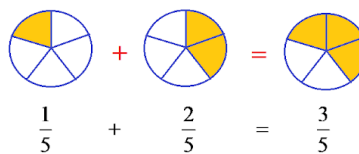
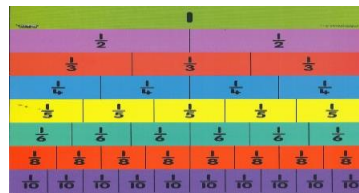
Class PE days are as follows: **Ocean**- Monday and Thursday **Secret Garden**- Monday and Thursday (Gym and Dance)

English

- ★ In **Writing**, we will be looking at **persuasive writing** techniques in the form of leaflets, advertising and Holiday brochures. In this genre, the specific **SPaG** skills we will be focusing on are using **paragraphs** to organise our writing, using appropriate **headings and subheadings**, varying the way we use **sentence openers** and learning about **rhetorical questions** to engage the reader
- ★ We will continue to use our new **Reading** resources, which have proved very popular so far. The children are gaining valuable experience through discussing many different texts and beginning to test their inference skills.
- ★ **Spellings** will continue in the form of the Spelling walls. Your child should have a copy of their spelling wall that they bring home with them. Each week, they will have 5 words that they have to learn.

Maths

- ★ In **Maths**, our main focus will shift to **Fractions**. This will include **pictorial representations of finding parts of a whole, equivalent fractions** using a **fraction wall**, using **number lines to represent fractions** and **unit and non-unit fractions**. We will also be looking at **adding fractions** together with the **same denominator**.
- ★ Times table knowledge is key and their understanding of number lines and pictorial representations will also be important.



Topic Learning

- ★ In **Science**, we will be studying Rocks. Looking at the different properties of rocks and running some tests to see which rocks would be better suited to specific jobs.
- ★ In **History**, we will be learning about Japan as linked to our topic 'Journey to the Unknown.' We will be looking at its fascinating and diverse culture. Studying 'The Samurai' and different Emperors as well as some significant events in their history such as the attack on Pearl Harbour.
- ★ In **Art**, we will be looking at creating pieces of artwork inspired by Japanese Cherry Blossom Trees.
- ★ In **DT** we are really excited about launching our first DT challenge. More news to follow in the coming weeks.
