Hello and welcome back, we hope you all had a lovely festive break and a happy start to the New Year! We have lots of exciting new learning for the children to experience this term. Firstly, we will spend the next few weeks finishing off our Egyptian learning in History and English before moving onto our new topic of Iceland.

English

- ★ **Writing** - the children will spend the first few weeks continuing to focus on the story of The Egyptian Cinderella with a technical focus on reported speech with their creative writing to be a news article about Rhodopis and her missing slipper. They will then move onto reading The Polar Bear explorers club. Their technical focus will be to begin to use subordinate clauses and adjectives when they write a diary entry as Stella and a setting description of the storm.
- ★ **Reading**- please continue to hear your child read at least four times a week. The first lot of reading badges were handed out at the end of last term.
- ★ **Spellings** – your child will continue to work through their spelling wall with additional topical vocabulary.

Maths

- ★ **Money**
To start this half term, Year 3 will be focusing on adding and subtracting money before moving on to working out change. Pupils will explore this in a real life context by running their own shop in the classroom.
- ★ **Multiplication and division**
To finish this half term, Year 3 will start to explore multiples in the 3, 4 and 8 times tables while also looking at dividing using 3, 4 and 8.
