English

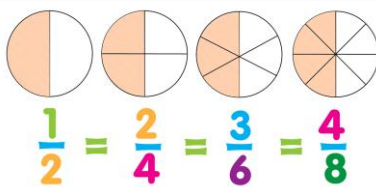
