# **English**

- ★ Writing the children will continue to read The Polar Bears' Explorers Club by Alex Bell as a class text. Using inspiration from this book, they will write an instructional text about how to make a potion to cure the dinosaur's skin problems. They will focus on a range of tenses when rewriting an opening paragraph and then finish the half term with creating a conversation between two characters of their choosing.
- ★ Reading- the second batch of reading badges will be handed out at the end of the half term. Please ensure you are hearing your child read at least four times a week and signing the calendar in their reading diaries.
- ★ Spellings your child will continue to work through their spelling wall with additional topical vocabulary.

# Maths

# **★** Multiplication and division

Year 3 will continue to focus on multiplication and division this half term. They will start with using a place value chart to multiply before focusing on column multiplication. They will then use their multiplication knowledge to divide with and without remainders.

# ★ 1- minute maths

Across the Spring term, we introduced a daily practice of times tables and number bonds to help boast the children's fluency. Each session, they have one minute to complete a short column of sums. They compete against themselves to improve their accuracy and time from their previous attempt. They have shown a real excitement around these and an improvement in their fluency.
