English

- ★ We will be using the novel 'Charlie and the Chocolate **Factory'** to help with our English this term. In particular the children will look at subordinate clauses when writing a character description and using the contraction and possessive apostrophe. They will write an about their advert chocolate bar and use persuasive features to convince Charlie's Mum to let them go to the chocolate factory.
- ★ Reading at home 4 times a week is still the minimum expected of all children. Some children will be aiming for their Gold badges this term whilst others are still able to claim their Bronze or Silver badges.
- ★ Spellings the children will continue to use their spelling walls. Do remind children to practice their spellings daily.

Maths

- ★ In maths we will start to look at length and perimeter where the children will practice measuring using m, cm and mm. They will also look at comparing, adding and subtracting lengths. Towards the end of this half term, they will learn about time.
- ★ We will continue to focus on consolidating times table knowledge and will encourage the children to continually learn and practise at home through the use of TTRockstars.
- ★ Children should continue to play **Numbots** to consolidate their addition and subtraction facts. Please do this regularly.

Topic Learning

- ★ In Science, we will be learning about States of matter and understanding solid, liquids and gases. Children will explore evaporation, condensation and the water cycle.
- ★ In Geography and History, we will look at The Ancient Mayans. Children will explore who they were, where they lived, their culture, farming techniques and society and the language, numbers and calendar they created. They will also learn about the history of chocolate and the cacao tree.
- ★ Computing: The Year 3 children will be learning about creating digital media.
- ★ RE: The children will learn about Christianity this half term.
- ★ **PSHE:** The children will learn about healthy bodies and healthy minds.
