## **English**

- ★ Poetry This term, we will be performing and writing various types of poems, such as kennings and narrative poetry. We will be focusing on rhyming couplets, syllables & rhythm, alliteration and onomatopoeia.
- ★ The SPaG skills we will be focusing on during this half term will include: verb inflections, noun phrases & prepositional phrases, e.g.

They was were getting ready for school.

That <u>new pink bike</u> is mine. ('Bike' is the noun and the other words which describe the bike make up the noun phrase)

#### He hid beneath the duvet.

- ★ Reading the children will continue to do weekly Cracking Comprehension sessions. Please continue to ensure your child has access to different texts at home to encourage reading for enjoyment.
- ★ Spellings the children have already received their spellings before the half term to practice at home in preparation for their fortnightly Friday quizzes.

### **Maths**

★ Money — Our new topic in mathematics will be money, where children will learn to convert between pounds and pence, and apply their place value knowledge to help them. We will then be using all four operations (= - x ÷) to solve money problems, e.g.

A class has £100 to spend on books.

#### **Book Prices**

Hardback = £8Paperback = £4

How many books could they buy for £100? How many different ways can yo find to do this?


★ Times Tables — By the end of Year 3, we hope all children will be able to confidently recall the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables. We will continue to do a weekly times tables quiz in class to encourage the children to identify which tables they need to practice.

# Experienceology

Our new topic is called 'Fire It Up!' and we will be exploring electricity and the Stone Age. We hope to do lots of outdoor learning where children will be doing orienteering around the school.

- ★ In Art & DT, children will be designing, creating and then evaluating their own Stone Age sculptures using clay, based on existing landmarks, such as Stone-Henge.
- ★ In **Science**, we will be learning about electricity and how to make working circuits using switches, lights and buzzers. Children will then use these skills to create their own working quiz game.
