TOP SCHOOL PORTS

Summer 2024 2nd Half Term - Year 3

English

- ★ Creative writing: This term the children will continue with writing creatively. The children will be writing a variety of genres including, newspaper reports, diary entry, and persuasive letters. We will be continue to use our class book, 'The Wind in the Willows', as inspiration for our writing.
- ★ Spelling: Please continue to practise spellings with your children at home. They need to develop their confidence with spelling most of their topic words correctly.
- continue **★** Reading: Please reading at home with the children. We are including written comprehension activities in our weekly English work this term; this is based on a non-fiction text about The Colorado and Danube rivers. To be successful in these activities the children need to be used to reading extending pieces writing and answering questions about what they have read.

Maths

★ Geometry

The children will extend their knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes by learning about their properties and learning to draw them accurately using rulers. They will also be learning how to describe angles and turns using the correct terminology and linking this to their knowledge of fractions and direction.

★ Time

Children will tell and write the time from an analogue clock. They will create their own clock face with moving hands; use Roman numerals and learn the 24 hour clock. Children will practise reading a digital clock and find the time to a 5 minute interval.



Children will work to solve word problems involving passing time (whole hours and half hours); and calculate the difference in time between two clocks.
