
Please ensure that your child/ren come to school with a labelled coat, water bottle and book bag each day. Thank you!

English

- ★ We will be using the novel 'Kensuke's Kingdom' to help with our English this term. In particular the children will look at plot, setting and characters.
- ★ Reading- our Guided Reading groups will continue, in addition to individual reading with an adult, ensuring the children have frequent practice at reading throughout the week.
- ★ Spellings the children will continue to use their spelling walls. Do remind children to practice their spellings daily.
- ★ Handwriting Your child will be able to practise their cursive Hilltop script handwriting using words from their spelling wall to write in sentences. We are beginning to look out for Year 4 children who are ready to be awarded a Pen licence.

Maths

★ In maths we will be continuing to secure and develop our Multiplication and division skills. The children will begin to look at using the more formal written methods working on multiplying and dividing 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by 1- digit numbers.



- ★ We will also take our first look at **Area, Length, Perimeter** and then start to look at **Fractions.**
- ★ We will continue to focus on consolidating times table knowledge and will encourage the children to continually learn and practise them at home through the use of TTRockstars.
- ★ Children can now also access **Numbots** to consolidate their addition and subtraction facts. Please do this regularly.

Topic Learning

- ★ In **Science**, we will be learning about **Light** and understanding how light works and why it behaves in certain ways.
- ★ In Geography and History, we will be using maps/ atlases and computers to locate countries, including Japan, and cities from around the world. We will also be looking at and comparing the climates of the UK and Japan. We will learn about Earthquakes and Tsunamis linking to the natural disaster that struck Japan in 2011.
- ★ Computing: The Year 4 children will be exploring web design.
- ★ RE: The children will learn about Hinduism this half term.
