



Spring 2026 2nd Half Term - Year 2

We hope you all had an enjoyable half term break. As with every year, time is flying by and we are already half way through the year! We are eager to welcome the children back into the classrooms. This half term will be filled with more fun, we are busy preparing for DT week and are looking forward to our Space Day – booked in on the 27th of February where the children will have the chance to enjoy a whole day of space themed activities!

English

★ **Non-Fiction Writing:** We will tie in what the children are learning about in History which will enable them to gain a deeper knowledge of the significant historical individuals and events. The children will need to ensure that their writing is factual, descriptive and well structured. We will be looking at some examples of different non-fiction texts to show the children what they should be working towards.

★ **Phonics and Spellings**

The children will continue to have new sounds introduced each week as well as recapping sounds that have previously learnt. This term we will begin learning more about writing in paragraphs. We are hoping that the children will become more confident at writing longer pieces of writing and will begin to use paragraphs effectively. Please continue to practise spellings with your children, it is important that they are able to spell most words correctly by the end of Year 2.

Maths

★ **Multiplication and Division:**

The children will continue learning about multiplication and division. We will be focusing on the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables and helping the children to count confidently in these increments. The children will also look at fact families relating to multiplication and division sums.

Fractions: looking at halves, thirds and quarters of shapes, amounts and numbers, building on learning from last year.

Time: reading the time on an analogue clock to the nearest 5 minutes as well as recognising quarter past, half past and quarter to.

Measurement: measuring, ordering and comparing lengths, weights, temperatures and capacities.
