English

- ★ **Writing** - the children will spend this term continuing to embed the use of direct speech within creative writing while exploring how to use a range of conjunctions. Year 4 children will learn about embedded clauses and will try using them in their sentences. All KS2 classes will continue to read Roman myths.
- ★ **Reading** - please continue to hear your child read at least four times a week. There are bronze, silver, gold and diamond reading awards for your child to earn. Do remember to sign the calendar at the front of your child's reading diary, each time you hear them read.
- ★ **Spellings** – your child will continue to work through their spelling wall with additional topical vocabulary.

Maths

- ★ **Multiplication and division**
Year 4 will continue their learning around multiplication and division with a focus on using formal methods.
- ★ **Area and Perimeter**
The children will be using their knowledge of addition and multiplication to find the area and perimeter of regular polygons.
