Sundew (Year 3&4) – Miss Mason, Mrs Brown, Ms Mills and Mrs Butler


Bracken (Year 4) – Miss Hichens, Ms Simpson, Mrs Hussain and Miss K

English

- ★ Writing the children will spend this half term looking at how sentences include nouns and verbs written in the present tense. We will begin to explore this by looking at examples of writing linking to our topic Stone Age to Iron Age.
- ★ Reading- we have spent lots of time reading and hearing the children read during these first few days back in school. Please ensure you hear your child read at least 4 times a week and record it in their yellow reading diaries.
- ★ Spellings Your child will soon bring home their spelling book with words to practise. They will have five spellings to learn each week and will spend some time in class understanding how to practice new spelling words.

Maths

★ Place Value- we will re-cap our knowledge of place value, extending children's knowledge of bigger, and more complex numbers. This will also develop their skills to round numbers up and down. We will begin with focusing on what the different numerals represent within a 2 and 3 digit number. The children will be using various physical resources to enable them to become more secure in their understanding of place value. We will work on finding 10 more and 10 less than any given 2 or 3 digit number.
