We finished off last half term with our **autumn Arts Week** in Years 1-4. This term's focus was line drawing with children in Years 1 and two looking at repeated patterns in decorative art and Years 3 and 4 considering three styles of architectural art with a specific focus on how artists make buildings appear 3D. For the first time ever, we would like to invite all parents/carers to come along to a mini exhibition to enjoy the final piece of work created by each child during Art week. The **exhibition will take place in the hall on Friday 21st November between 3 and 4pm**. You have the option

of popping in before pick up time or coming along afterwards with your child.















We try to give the children the opportunity to use good quality resources during our termly art weeks and ask each year for parental contributions to help with the cost of these resources. The **three £5 contributions** per child across the year also cover the cost of materials used in Design Technology weeks including Food Technology and other consumable used through the year in subjects such as science at Key Stage 1 and 2 level.

In Nursey, Reception and Dandelion classes, the **three £5 contributions** are used to purchase ingredients for baking and playdough as well as consumable tactile and sensory resources. The option of making these payments will be visible in Arbor from the end of this week.
